Mr. Brant Lane Craig, 56 of Fort Payne died Thursday July 16, 2009. Brant was born July 1, 1953 son of the late Lloyd Craig. He was very active in community activities, Kiwanis Club, in 1998 & 2002 he was given the Award of Distinction, Fort Payne Parks & Recreation Boosters, Fort Payne High School Athletic Boosters, Fort Payne Chamber of Commerce, June Jam Softball Coordinator 1982-1996, Big Oak Trail Ride Coordinator, Alabama Treasure Forest Association, Alabama Sports Hall of Fame Selection Committee, National Wild Turkey Federation, Alabama Cattlemen's Association, Salvation Army, Dekalb County, Tarcog, Tarpo.
