



## Clifford "Tom" Satterlee

Clifford (Tom) Satterlee passed away on February 5, 2023 at his daughter's, Elizabeth Stephens, home in Mentone, Alabama. He was born and raised in New Orleans where he graduated from Holy Cross High School. He was drafted into the Navy at 18 and was a World War II veteran serving as an aviation radioman in the South Pacific.
