Curtis Harold O'Daniel Sr., 76, of Fort Payne, passed away at his residence Tuesday, March 6, 2018. He was born on June 24, 1941, in Red Hill, Alabama to the late Woodrow and Mildred Baker O'Daniel.

Curtis graduated from Tallassee High School in 1960 and received a basketball scholarship to Auburn University where he played ball from 1960 to 1965. He earned both a bachelor's and a master's degree in agriculture from Auburn and was proud to be a Golden Eagle. He loved the Auburn Tigers and always enjoyed attending football and basketball games. He served as president of the DeKalb Auburn Club.

Curtis was employed by the Auburn Extension Service for 31 years. He began his career in Marshall County and served as an agent in Cherokee and Talladega Counties before moving to Fort Payne as County Agent Coordinator in 1978. During his career in Extension in DeKalb County he was instrumental in organizing the Home and Garden Show in Rainsville and the Farmers Market in Fort Payne, as well as many other programs to benefit farmers and residents of this county.

He received many awards and honors throughout his career and served as state president of the Alabama County Agricultural Agents Association. He was a member of First Baptist Church where he taught Sunday School and

served on committees.

Curtis was a loving husband, father, and grandfather. He loved hunting, fishing, gardening, and helping people with their problems. He is survived by his wife of 52 years, Judy Callaway O'Daniel, daughter, Claire and her husband, Paul Hajek, son, Curt and his wife, Cynthia O'Daniel, son, Chris O'Daniel, grandson, Trey and his wife, Manda O'Daniel, two sisters, four brothers, and many nieces and nephews.

A celebration of his life will be held Friday at 2 p.m. at First Baptist Church in Fort Payne with visitation from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. prior to the service. Dr. Nathan VanHorn and Dr. R. Pat McFadden will conduct the service with eulogies from friends.

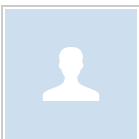
