Doris Lovvorn Craig, 90-1/2, of Fort Payne went to be with the Lord and her husband. She passed Monday, February 26, 2018 at Dekalb Regional Medical Center. She was born July 11, 1927. Doris was the only child of Mr. Chelsea Lovvorn and Mrs. Florence Steward Lovvorn of Fort Payne.

Funeral services will be held Saturday, March 3, 2018 at First Baptist Church. Visitation will be 1 p.m. til 3 p.m. Burial will follow in Glenwood Cemetery, next to her loving husband, Lloyd Craig.

She was a member of First Baptist Church of Fort Payne where she was an assistant director of the High School Sunday School class Department for approximately 20 years. After graduating from Dekalb High School in 1945, she attended Business School in Birmingham, where she was a member of the girls basketball team.
