Edward Franklin Stuckey, 90, of Fort Payne, passed away Wednesday, October 22, 2015. Mr. Stuckey was a 1942 graduate of Dasher Bible School in Valdosta, GA. He attended one year of college at the University of Alabama. In 1943, he met his future wife of 65 years, Rita Corley Stuckey, in Birmingham while he was a Second Lieutenant in the U.S. Army. He went on to serve for 31 years in the U.S. Air Force as a Chief Master Sergeant. During his service, he was involved in three wars: World War II, Korean, and Vietnam.

Funeral services will be 4 p.m. Sunday at Wilson Funeral Home. The family will receive friends Sunday from 2 until 4 p.m. In lieu of flowers, the family requests memorial contributions be made to one of his favorite charities: St. Jude's or the First United Methodist Church Youth Program.

Mr. Stuckey is survived by his son and daughter-in-law; Edward and Jean Stuckey of Fort Payne; daughter, Linda Stuckey Castner of Cullman; seven grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren.

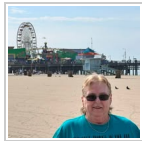
