



Elbert A. Dodd

December 31, 1934 - October 10, 2023

Elbert Allen Dodd passed away October 10, 2023 in Fort Payne, Alabama. He was born in Jay, Florida on December 31, 1934 to parents Marion Elbert Dodd and Minnie Bell Dodd. Mr. Dodd graduated from Gadsden High School in 1953. He served in the United States Naval Reserves from 1953 to 1956. He attended Jefferson State Junior College and Jacksonville State University. Mr. Dodd was a City of Birmingham police officer from 1959 until 1980. He retired at the rank of Sergeant Detective (CAW). He was the president of the City of Birmingham Fraternal Order of Police. During his tenure as president, he served as a registered lobbyist in both the Alabama Legislature and the United States House of Representatives. He was instrumental in the passage of the Birmingham Police Department's 20-year retirement plan, and successfully lobbied for federal survivor benefits for police officers killed in the line of duty. He was employed as a bailiff in the Jefferson County court system from 1990 to 2000. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Fort Payne.

Graveside services will be 11 a.m. Thursday at Glenwood Cemetery with Dr. Marshall Henderson and Dr. Pat McFadden officiating. The family will receive friends Wednesday evening from 5 until 7 p.m. In lieu of flowers, the family requests memorial contributions to the Big Oak Ranch, 250 Jake Mintz Road, Gadsden, AL 35905.

Mr. Dodd is survived by his wife, Eula Dodd and sons, Allen Dodd (wife

Melinda) and David Dodd (wife Vicki). He is also survived by many grandchildren and great grandchildren.
