Mrs. Etta Griffin, of Centre, formerly of Fort Payne, was called to her eternal home on Sunday, May 13, 2012 while surrounded by her family at her residence. Mrs. Griffin was born in Chattanooga, TN on March 6, 1923 to Homer and Alpha Prewett Carnes. She retired from Black's Department Store but is probably better remembered for her work at both the DeKalb and Cherokee Hospitals where she and her husband volunteered through the Red Cross. More importantly, she was a loving mother, a very supportive pastor's wife for 50 plus years, and a member of the First Baptist Church of Centre. Funeral services will be 11:00am Tuesday, May 15, 2012 at Broadway Baptist Church in Rainsville with Rev. Charles Jones, Rev. Kevin McCreless, and Rev. Ken Clements officiating. Burial will follow in the Mountain View Memory Gardens. The body will lie in state at the church from 10:00am until time for service. The family will receive friends on Monday evening 4:00 until 8:00pm at the funeral home.
