Faye Woolf Thompson, 83, of Fort Payne, passed away Wednesday, July 26, 2017. She was born on October 21, 1933 in Gadsden, Alabama to the late Horace D. and Bonnie Leath Woolf. A 1955 graduate of Auburn University with a degree in foreign language, she was a retired English teacher with tenure in both Plainview School and Fort Payne High School. Mrs. Thompson was a 58 year member of First United Methodist Church. Active in her community, Mrs. Thompson was the founder and first president of the Fort Payne Culture Club and she served as president of the Fort Payne Jayceettes. In 1974, she was initiated into Delta Kappa Gamma, an international professional honor society for key women educators.

Funeral services will be 11 a.m. Friday at Wilson Funeral Home with Rev. Ricky Smith officiating. Burial will follow in Glenwood Cemetery. The family will receive friends Thursday from 5 until 8 p.m. In lieu of flowers, the family suggests contributions be made to First United Methodist Church of Fort Payne.

She is survived by her husband of 62 years, Sidney L. Thompson; daughters Cindy McDaniel and husband, Frank, and Mary Schaunaman and husband, Mark; grandchildren, Garrett McDaniel, Christian McDaniel, and Jennifer Fong and husband, Carlos; and great-granddaughter, Audrey Fong.
