



Rev. Fred E. Higgins

August 4, 1925 - September 21, 2008

Rev. Fred E. Higgins Jr., age 83 of Ft. Payne, died Sunday September 21, 2008. Mr. Higgins was born in Commerce, Georgia on August 4, 1925, son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Fred E. Higgins, Sr. Mr. Higgins earned a diploma from Extension Division of Samford University in May 1988. He earned a Lifelong Learning Diploma of Superior Achievement Extension Division of Samford University in May 1994 and a Lifelong Distinguished Diploma from Samford University Extension Division in May 1997. Mr. Higgins was ordained to the Gospel Ministry on February 24, 1991. He started as pastor at Sallie Howard Memorial Chapel in October 1990 serving until 2008. He was also a veteran of the United States Army Air Force and served in World War II where he flew 33 missions. Survivors include his wife, Phiba Westmoreland Higgins of Fort Payne; Daughter and Son-in-Law, Amy and Mark Pope of Huntsville; Sisters, Eddie Benson of Cullman and Alyce Durrence of Brevard, NC. Funeral services will be 2:00 PM Tuesday from the Wilson Funeral Home Chapel with the Rev. Orion Ledford and Rev. Charles Jones officiating. Burial will be in the Mt. View Memorial Gardens Cemetery.
