Mr. G.B. Beasley, age 86 of Fort Payne, passed away Thursday, March 30, 2017. Mr. Beasley was born in Montgomery, AL, on Dec. 3, 1930, son of the late George William and Emily Elizabeth Davidson Beasley. Mr. Beasley was a retired Principal and Coach with Fort Payne High School for 15 years, Etowah High School, Cherokee Co. High School, Albertville High School and Haleyville High School.
