Hubert McPherson, 84, of Fort Payne passed away Tuesday, April 12, 2016 at his home. Mr. McPherson was born May 19, 1931 to the late Rufus Otto and Nora Bell Harper McPherson. He retired a Colonel with the Army National Guard, serving over 34 years. After his retirement, he began a second career as a compliance officer with First Fidelity Bank. Mr. McPherson was an avid coin collector. He was known for his booth at Trade Day which he had been active in since the late 70's. Mr. McPherson was a faithful church member of Second Baptist Church where he had attended since he was 10 years old.

On October 17, 2010, Mr. McPherson's beloved wife, Bobbie Jean, passed away. Since that day, he never missed one day visiting her graveside and every Sunday, he brought her roses.
