



Dr. James Bobby Roebuck

July 14, 1932 - February 24, 2009

Dr. James Bobby Roebuck, age 76, of Fort Payne passed away Tuesday, February 24, 2009. Dr. Roebuck was born in Gadsden, Alabama on July 14, 1932 to James Thomas and Velma Woods Roebuck. He graduated from Gadsden High School in 1949. Dr. Roebuck graduated from the University of Alabama Dental School in 1964 where he finished in the top 10 percent of the national class. He began his 45-year dentistry practice in Fort Payne in July of 1964 and continued to serve his patients until his death. Dr. Roebuck was a member of the Alabama Dental Association and the National Dental Association. In his youth, Dr. Roebuck was a semi-professional baseball player in Gadsden, Alabama. He was as a veteran of the US Navy during the Korean conflict where he served as a radioman on the minesweeper, USS SAGE. Dr. Roebuck was a member of First Baptist Church of Fort Payne where he served as a deacon and Sunday School teacher. He was also a member of the Coffee Club, Delta Sigma Delta Fraternity, and a past member of Rotary Club. Funeral services will be 1 p.m. Thursday, February 26, 2009 at First Baptist Church with Dr. Pat McFadden and Dr. Dan Ireland officiating. Burial will follow in Glenwood Cemetery with military honors. The family requests in lieu of flowers, memorial contributions be made to First Baptist Church.
