Judge Lee Clyde Traylor, age 76, passed away Sunday, November 16, 2008 at his home. He served 13 years as District Judge and retired in 2003. After retiring, he continued to volunteer his time each Friday to serve as judge and held court for child support cases each month. Judge Traylor received many honors and accolades during his tenure as district judge and touched countless lives throughout this state.
