Kevin Joseph Genelin, 54, of Fort Payne passed away Monday June 27, 2011, in Birmingham at UAB Hospital. Kevin was born November 28, 1956, in Le Centre, MN, and spent the majority of his early life in Tomahawk, WI. He moved to Fort Payne in 1982. He was formerly the Plant Manager of the Heil Corporation, and he was the V.P. and General Manager of Industrial Packaging Corporation. He was also a member of the Our Lady of the Valley Catholic Church, where he served as Parish Council President and was active in the Religious Education Program, the RCIA Program, and the Birmingham Cursillo Movement, where he served as secretary to the Secretariat. Kevin enjoyed fishing, hunting, carpentry, portrait drawing, and playing cribbage, but most of all he loved spending time with friends and family. He was an active member of the community and donated both his time and his goodwill to anyone in need. Funeral Mass will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday at the Our Lady of the Valley Catholic Church. The family will receive friends on Friday from 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. at Wilson Funeral Home.
