Louis Friedman Herzberg, 78, of Fort Payne died Sunday, October 2, 2011 at DeKalb Regional Medical Center. He was the son of the late Bernhard and Margeret Moore Herzberg and the grandson of the late Judge Louis L. Herzberg of Gadsden. Mr. Herzberg received his B.A. degree from Birmingham Southern College and his Masters degree from the University of Alabama. He served two years in the Army artillery, taught history at Mississippi State College for Women and worked for 28 years as an Air Force civilian, after which he retired in 1988, at Little Rock Air Force Base, Arkansas. He served many years as President of the local chapter of the National Association of Retired Federal Employees. Funeral services will be 10:30 a.m. Thursday from St. Phillips Episcopal Church with graveside service following at 2:30 p.m. in Forest Cemetery in Gadsden, AL. The family will receive friends Wednesday from 4 until 7 p.m. at Wilson Funeral Home.
