



Maxie Maureen Shavers

February 21, 1928 - December 22, 2012

Maxie Maureen Hollingsworth Shavers, of Fort Payne, passed away on December 22, 2012 at Gadsden Regional Medical Center following surgery. Mrs. Shavers was born on February 21, 1928 in Smith County, Mississippi, one of eleven children born to Floyd and Fannie Idell Hollingsworth. She was Valedictorian of her high school class and played semi-pro basketball following high school. In 1949, she met her future husband, Eulas Roy Shavers, who was working as a jeweler at the Jackson, Mississippi Sears & Roebuck. Their first date was to dinner following a basketball game played by Maxie's Flying Fish basketball team. Roy and Maxie were married later that year and celebrated 63 years of marriage. After retiring from Kingsberry Homes, where she was an Administrative Assistant, Maxie received numerous degrees from Northeast Alabama Community College. She also became a licensed realtor. Mrs. Shavers was a member of Second Baptist Church of Fort Payne where she taught Sunday School for many years. She was also a member of Order of the Eastern Star. Mrs. Shavers is survived by her husband, Eulas Roy Shavers, two daughters Patricia Shavers and Angela Shavers Wilson, grandchildren, Bucky Herrin, Jon David Scott, Rob Wilson, Michael Thyberg, Allison Wilson Fowlkes and Julie Wilson Portera; and seven great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her step-daughter Phyllis Thyberg. Funeral services will be 1 p.m. Wednesday, December 26th from the Wilson Funeral Home Chapel in Fort Payne, Alabama.
