Charles Neil Jones, 64, of the Adamsburg community, passed away Saturday, December 17, 2016 at Grandview Medical Center in Birmingham. Mr. Jones was born in Fort Payne on January 19, 1952 to the late George H. and Gladys Barkley Jones.
