Mr. Paul LeRoy Tucker, Sr, of Rainbow City, Al. formerly of Fort Payne went home Friday at his residence surrounded by his family. Mr. Tucker was born in Dekalb Co. Al. on Dec. 22, 1922 son of the late Rev. H.B. Tucker and Mattie Jewel Mince Tucker. He was preceded in death by a grandson, Maury Vann Smith. He was a veteran of the U.S. Navy, serving as a Chief Petty Officer, having served his country from 1942 until 1952 on active duty in the U.S. Coast Guard and U.S. Navy during WW II and the Korean War. He was honorably discharged in 1981 from the US Naval Reserve. Mr. Tucker had worked for Sears & Roebuck Co. and was retired from the Civil Service, Panama City, Fl. He was a member of the 12th. Street Baptist Church, where he served as a deacon, leader of the Royal Ambassadors and basketball coach. In 1986, he was a member of the First Baptist Church, Fort Payne and attended the Baracca Sunday School Class. He was also a former member of the St. Andrews Baptist Church, Panama City, Fl. He was very active in community activities, including the Campers on Missions, Alhambra Shriners, Chattanooga, Tn., Fort Payne Masonic Lodge, # 437 F & AM, order of the Eastern Star, Grand Chapter of Alabama, Ft. Payne 414 (Worthy Patron). Funeral services will be 1:00 PM Monday from the Wilson Funeral Home Chapel, Fort Payne, with Dr. Troy Morrison officiating. Eulogy by Capt. Paul Tucker, Jr. Burial will be at 3 PM Monday from the Rainbow Memorial Gardens, Gadsden with Masonic Graveside Rites. Fort Payne Masonic Lodge will serve as pallbearers. The family will receive friends from 11 AM Monday
