Bethel Ray Stone, of Fort Payne, passed away on July 2, 2014 from an extended illness. Mr. Stone was 79 years old and grew up in Sylvania, Alabama and was a graduate of Sylvania High School class of 1954.

Mr. Stone was an active member of the Ft. Payne community serving on the City Council and Water Board as well as a Poll Supervisor for 20 years. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge 437 serving as Worshipful Master in 1989-90; a Charter Member of the Fort Payne Optimist Club participating in programs such as Feed the Needy, Relay for Life and Race for the Cure. He was a member of the Executive Committee for DeKalb County Democratic Party as well as Drug Free DeKalb County.

Mr. Stone was a small business owner in Fort Payne operating an Appliance Repair Business and having the local Roto Rooter franchise. He attended St Paul Methodist Church.

Prior to returning to DeKalb County, Mr. Stone served for a number of years in Law Enforcement in Marshall County.

He was preceded in death by his parents W. A. Stone and Lera Stone; brothers Floyd Stone, Creed Stone and sister Hazel Wood.
