



Robert Lloyd Hoskinson

December 17, 1937 - April 4, 2012

Mr. Robert Lloyd Hoskinson, age 74, of Fort Payne, passed away Wednesday, April 4, 2012 at his residence. Mr. Hoskinson was born December 17, 1937 in Mount Carmel, Illinois, the son of Everett and Estelle Windes Hoskinson. He married Sheila Kay Frazier on August 19, 1962 at First Presbyterian Church in Effingham, Illinois. He graduated from Mount Carmel High School in 1956. That same year, he entered the United States Army and served two years with the 25th Infantry Division at Scholfield Barracks in Hawaii. At the completion of his enlistment, he attended Southern Illinois University in Carbondale, Illinois where he received a Bachelor of Science degree in education. He was a member of Tau Kappa Epsilon fraternity. He taught elementary school from 1962 through 1972 in both Los Angeles, California and Decatur, Illinois. In 1972, he graduated from Eastern Illinois University, in Charleston, Illinois, with a Masters in Science; and in 1975 with an Ed.S in Educative Administration. Mr. Hoskinson spent the rest of his career in education as Correlator of Gifted Programs, Director of Staff Development, k – 10 principal and superintendent of schools. He retired in 1998. He is survived by his wife: Sheila Kay Frazier Hoskinson of Fort Payne; son: Brett Robert Hoskinson of Nashville, TN; daughter and son-in-law: Shay Lynn & Brett Odom of Jasper, AL; sister-in-law: Carole Frazier; nephew: Sgt 1st Class Robert (Cathy) Frazier; and grandchildren: Jacob Michael Huff, Kaitlen Elizabeth Huff, Macon Zachery Odom, Brittany Diane Odom, and Joshua Charles (J.C.)
