Sidney Lee Thompson, 89, of Fort Payne, Alabama, passed away Thursday, October 6, 2022. He was born February 7, 1933 in Fort Payne to the late James Ernest Thompson and Lucille Tiner Thompson. He served in the United States Army as a medical officer in the Third Infantry Division. Mr. Thompson graduated Auburn University School of Pharmacy in 1955 and owned and operated Fort Payne Drug Co. for nearly 50 years. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge #437, the Alhambra Shriners, and the Lions Club and was a lifelong member of Fort Payne United Methodist Church.

Funeral services will be 3 p.m. Sunday, October 9th at Wilson Funeral Home with burial following in Glenwood Cemetery. The family will receive friends Sunday from 1 p.m. until the 3 p.m. hour of service.
