Mr. Stephen Patrick Burt, age 64, of Fort Payne passed away January 12, 2017 at UAB Medical Center. Mr. Burt was born March 24, 1952 to the late Alton Richard and Margaret Carr Burt. Stephen was a deacon of Gravel Hill Baptist Church. He was a member of Fort Payne Masonic Lodge #437, F&AM, Dekalb/Jackson County Square and Compass Club, and the Alhambra Shrine and was a draftsman at Vulcraft for 27 years before retiring.

Stephen was able to share 17 years of life with his family and friends thanks to the generosity of a lung donor, Christopher Pobanz.

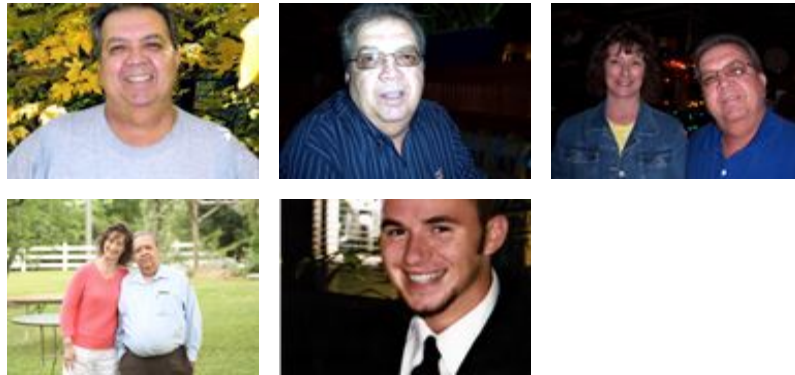
