Wayne Hardman, 84 of Fort Payne passed away Tuesday, November 17, 2015. He was born on December 16, 1930, to the late Clifford Claude and Myrtle Ellen Hardman. He served two years in the Army in Germany during the Korean War. He held a bachelor's degree from Jacksonville State University and a master's degree from the University of Alabama. He served 13 years as principal and coach at Sylvania High School and 15 years at Ider High School as a principal and coach. The football stadium at Ider is named in his honor. He loved Alabama football and playing golf.
