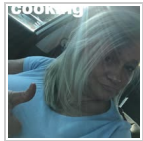

“ I only met you in person a few times Anita but I feel like I know you well. You were so kind to me when I first met you at the Chamber office last year and introduced myself. When I told you that I was with Manitou Cave of Alabama you immediately told me about Wes. While I was visiting with Carol, you found a photo of Wes when he was a teen, standing in front of the Manitou visitor center. You printed a copy of the photo and gave it to me. I love that photo and feel connected to you and him. Years ago I was a nurse at a day treatment rehab center for people with head injuries called Phoenix Rising. It was the private practice of a physical therapist who saw the need for such a place. Most of the clients were paralyzed young men whose 1-2k insurance policy had run out and now they were home under the care of their families. At Phoenix rising, a member from each clients family volunteered one day a week, like a mother's day out. We worked together there like a family. So when I met you and you briefly told me about Wes I had deep respect & compassion. Last thursday, June 28 when I called you at the office the day of the Chamber after hours event planned for manitou that nite, you told me that you could not attend since you were sick. You sounded very sick on the phone. At the event, i was going to give you a Manitou Cave of Alabama with logo t-shirt for Wes. The next thing I saw on FB was that Wes had been in ICU & passed on. I regret that I'm unable to attend the services today, but want you to know that I'm with you in spirit. I have lit a candle for you and Wes and pray that he rest in eternal peace and that you be in the loving arms of comfort and support.
