William R. (Bill) Biddle, 87, a long-time resident of Fort Payne, Alabama, passed away on December 3, 2022, in Birmingham, Alabama. He was born in Gadsden, Alabama on July 12, 1935, to the late William W. Biddle and Eva Biddle. He graduated from Gadsden High School in 1954 and from Jacksonville State University in 1960.
